Young people on the global stage: their education and influence is a three year project funded by the European Union, with three European partners: Tide~ global learning in the UK; Humboldt-Universitaet zu Berlin, Germany; FERE-CECA in Madrid, Spain.

It will bring together teachers from these countries, and from West Africa, to share teaching ideas and develop resources on global themes over a three year period. It will be particularly relevant to science, history, modern foreign languages, geography and citizenship.
