How will the World Cup impact on the residents of Cape Town?

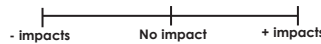


Objectives

- To understand how the 2010 World Cup will impact on residents of Cape Town
- To be able to evaluate the impact on individuals
- To work effectively in pairs to complete the task

Resources

- Character profiles (1 between 2)
- Impact scale (1 between 2)
- Quote from Mike Davies [see introduction 



Lesson Activities

- Introduce characters involved and read one profile as a class. Model a discussion to show how to reach a joint decision.
- Pupils to work in pairs to place characters along the impact scale to show either positive, negative or no impact of the 2010 World Cup. Emphasise that it is the discussion and not just the end result that is important.
- Feedback as a class — draw out any differences and encourage pupils to justify their decisions.
- Individuals compose a 30 second sound bite for a character — expressing their views on the World Cup. [This could be recorded]

Plenary

Read the quote from Mike Davies and get pupils to assess how much they agree with him. This can be along a line similar to the one used above.

Outcomes

All pupils to:

- Describe some of the benefits of the World Cup

Most pupils to:

- Describe benefits and reservations about the World Cup

Some pupils to:

- Weigh up the relative benefits and drawbacks of the World Cup.
